## **ACCESSING A STUDENT 504 ACCOMODATION PLAN (504-8)**

In 2019, Seattle Public Schools purchased a program which allows the Student 504 Department to become paperless by housing the documents within this program (504 Module). Because of this new program, Parents/Guardians will now have access to their student's 504 Eligibility Determination (504-6) and Accommodation plan (504-8) via the Source.

#### HOW TO


1. To access The Source, enter <a href="https://ps.seattleschools.org/">https://ps.seattleschools.org/</a> in your web browser.

- 2. Enter your Username and Password and click the Login button.
- 3. On the left navigation panel of The Source, click on the 504 Home link with the blue 504 icon.
- 4. The My Home Page in the 504 Module will open. There are two sections you will see: Alert Announcements and Quick Access.
  - a. Alert Announcement will notify you of any upcoming down times. For example, when Maintenance on the module will occur.
  - b. Quick Access is where you will be able to view your child's 504-8 plan. Click on the **504-8 Individual 504 Plan** link.
